

## **CORONADO SHORES BEACH CLUB, INC. (CSBC)**

### **CSBC AND STATE POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. All guests must be accompanied by Property Owner or immediate family member. Property owners, parents, or adult children or adult grandchildren shall be considered immediate family members. Minor grandchildren shall be considered guests. It is the property owner's responsibility to register the names of immediate family members with the CSBC caretaker, who will keep the names on file at the Clubhouse.
2. All swimmers, including guests, must be signed in by the property owner or immediate family member. The maximum number of guests per property shall be four at a time.
3. All swimmers must be signed in at least 30 minutes before the pool closes.
4. Proper behavior (no running or horseplay) is required of all users of the pool. The Caretaker will ask unruly persons to leave the pool area. If there is any confrontation, the Caretaker will call a Board Member to enforce the directive. Any violation of the pool rules will mean loss of privileges for this day. If there is further non-compliance, swimming privileges may be denied for a longer duration by direction of the Board.
5. Any person who is incontinent or not fully potty-trained must wear appropriate waterproof clothing when entering or being carried into the pool.
6. Each swimmer is required to take a cleansing shower before entering the pool.
7. Only water-resistant/water proof suntan lotion is allowed in the pool. All other lotions or oils must be removed by showering before entering the pool.
8. Long hair must be securely tied or covered.
9. No person will be allowed to swim alone without an observer present.
10. No food or drink will be allowed in the pool area except on the wooden deck.
11. Persons without swimming skills must be accompanied by a person with swimming skills. Persons 14 and under must have adult supervision.
12. No street shoes are allowed on the deck around the pool.
13. No rocks or coins are allowed in the pool area.
14. No person suffering from a communicable disease transmissible via water or person under the influence of an intoxicating liquor or drug shall use the pool.
15. The pool limit at any one time is 25 people. If this number is exceeded, property owners have first privileges.
